RACV BIKE ASSIST

Geoff James has investigated the costs and benefits of RACV BikE Assist. This is what he has found out...

You can have your Bike covered for roadside assistance through the RACV in the following ways:

If you have RACV Total Care (for your vehicle/s) you are automatically covered for Bike Assist. Alternatively, you can take out a separate Bike Assist policy, the cost is currently \$47.00 per year.

I recently changed a tyre and tube (rear wheel on the E Bike) in my garage, in the end I had to get help from Jim Hayes to refit the wheel, and that was with the bike suspended on a Bike Stand. Jim and I agreed that it would be near impossible to do it on the side of the road.

I reckon RACV Bike Assist is worth having, especially if you're on the wrong side of 'Senior Citizenship'.


